¹ Sexual Misconduct is an umbrella term that refers to all forms of sex and gender-based harassment and other forms of interpersonal violence. Under [UVA’s Policy on Sexual and Gender-Based Harassment and Other Forms of Interpersonal Violence \(referred to as the “Sexual Misconduct Policy”\)](#), this is referred to as Prohibited Conduct and includes any report to UVA alleging sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, domestic violence, stalking, sexual exploitation, and complicity. Each type of Prohibited Conduct is fully defined in the policy.

² Upon receipt of a report, the university promptly reaches out to the potential Complainant, if known, to offer support and resources regardless of whether a Respondent is named or known to the university and regardless of whether the Complainant is seeking a formal investigation and resolution process.

³ Other types of sanctions applied include, but are not limited to, suspension held in abeyance, degree revocation, coaching sessions, restitution, community service, no contact and no trespass orders. Typically, a Respondent found responsible will have more than one type of sanction applied. This number represents cumulative sanctions.

⁴ 2020-2021 data is not yet complete as some cases are still in the investigation/adjudication phase.
